Amendment to the Bilateral Compliance Agreement between the Oregon Health Authority and the City of Bend, PWS OR4100100

The City of Bend (the City) entered into a bilateral compliance agreement (BCA) with the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) on October 1, 2014.

The aforementioned agreement set forth actions to be completed by the City to construct an approved surface water treatment system. The Agreement also stipulates the City will monitor for *Cryptosporidium spp*. every month until conditions related to construction of the treatment system are complete. The City however does not utilize its surface water source for drinking water purposes every calendar month and both parties agree that monitoring for *Cryptosporidium* is unnecessary during those times.

DWS therefore agrees to an amendment of Agreement Activity No. 3 in the BCA as specified below.

- Agreement Activity No. 3: The City will conduct monitoring for *Cryptosporidium* every month until the completion of Agreement Activity No. 2 except during months when it does not utilize its surface water source for drinking water purposes for the entire month.
 - 1. Samples will be collected from the surface water source prior to any water treatment and submitted for laboratory analysis according to OAR 333-061-0036(1).
 - 2. The City will report monitoring results to DWS within 10 days of receiving the analysis report from the laboratory.

DWS and the City agree that this amendment applies only to the specific compliance action identified above, and does not constitute a waiver, modification, or suspension of any other agreement activity, requirement, or term specified in the BCA signed by DWS on October 1, 2014, which remains in full force and effect.
