RE: Extension to the Bilateral Compliance Agreement between the Oregon Health Authority and Laurel Acres Water Company, Inc., PWS OR4100217

Laurel Acres Water Company, Inc. (the Company) entered into a bilateral compliance agreement (BCA) with the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) on June 7, 2011. The Company subsequently agreed to the terms of an amended BCA and signed the agreement on March 29, 2012.

Each aforementioned agreement set forth actions to be completed by the Company to protect water users against fecal contamination of the groundwater well serving the Laurel Acres water system. The Company obtained the necessary funding but was unable to complete construction of a new water source due to circumstances beyond its control.

Based on the Company's progress to satisfy the terms of the BCA signed on March 29, 2012, DWS agrees to an extension of Agreement Activity No. 1 and Agreement Activity No. 2 in that agreement as specified below.

TERMS OF THE EXTENSION

- The Company will submit construction and site plans for a new water source to serve the Laurel Acres water system no later than June 30, 2015.
- The Company will demonstrate, no later than September 30, 2015, that it has:
 - Completed construction of a new water source for the Laurel Acres water system; and
 - Disconnected the groundwater well identified by well log "WASH 10896" from the Laurel Acres water system.


- DWS and the Company agree that this extension applies only to the specific compliance actions identified above, and does not constitute a waiver, modification, or suspension of any other agreement activity, requirement, or term specified in the BCA signed by DWS on April 6, 2012, which remains in full force and effect.
