RE: Notice of Non-Compliance regarding the HIGHLAND MOBILE HOME PARK Public Water System, PWS OR4100350

Dear PAT PATTERSON,

HIGHLAND MOBILE HOME PARK is a public water system subject to regulation under ORS 448.115 to 448.290 and OAR 333-061-0005 to 333-061-0290.

The Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Office of Environmental Public Health, Drinking Water Program (Program) has reviewed the operation of the HIGHLAND MOBILE HOME PARK water system and found that it is not being operated in compliance with the Oregon Drinking Water Quality Act (ORS 448.115 to ORS 448.290) and rules. Specifically:

• Compliance Deficiency No. 1: OAR 333-061-0036(3)(a) requires sampling for synthetic organic chemicals, but synthetic organic chemical sampling results have not been submitted for the HIGHLAND MOBILE HOME PARK water system for the most recently completed monitoring period, which constitutes a violation of the rule if samples were in fact not collected.

ACTIONS REQUIRED TO ACHIEVE COMPLIANCE

In order for the operation of HIGHLAND MOBILE HOME PARK water system to return to compliance with OAR 333-061-0036(3)(a), synthetic organic chemical sampling results collected during the current monitoring period must be submitted to the Program no later than January 10, 2012.

Failure to comply with the deadline specified in this letter may result in additional enforcement action, which could include the assessment of civil penalties as prescribed by OAR 333-061-0090. Please contact JOSEPHINE COUNTY at 541-474-5338 to discuss the compliance actions specified in this letter.
