RE: Extension to the Bilateral Compliance Agreement between the Oregon Health Authority and the City of Monument, PWS OR4100541

The City of Monument (the City) entered into a bilateral compliance agreement (BCA) with the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) on March 21, 2013.

The aforementioned agreement set forth actions to be completed by the City to construct and install an approved filtration system to treat the City's water source which has been classified as groundwater under the direct influence of surface water. The City has obtained the necessary funding but is unable to complete construction and installation by the agreement date in the aforementioned BCA due to the delay in obtaining funding.

Based on the City's progress to satisfy the terms of the BCA signed on March 21, 2013, DWS agrees to an extension of Agreement Activity No. 1 in that agreement as specified below.

#### TERMS OF THE EXTENSION

- The City will submit complete construction plans to DWS identifying the filtration treatment to be installed at the Monument water system no later than December 31, 2016.
- DWS and the City agree that this extension applies only to the specific compliance actions identified above, and does not constitute a waiver, modification, or suspension of any other agreement activity, requirement, or term specified in the BCA signed by DWS on March 21, 2013, which remains in full force and effect.
