This letter is a follow-up to the arsenic sample collected at PWS 01165 McKee Bridge Mobile Home Park on June 29, 2015. The 0.03 ppm sample result exceeds the 0.01 ppm Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL), and, as a result, the Oregon Health Authority is requiring the following action from McKee Bridge Mobile Home Park:

- (1) Troubleshoot/diagnose/repair the arsenic treatment system within two weeks.
- (2) Collect an arsenic sample after repairs are completed and send the result to our office when you receive it.
- (3) Collect arsenic samples on a monthly schedule for a period of no less than three months beginning in August.
- (4) Submit a corrective action plan to our office within two weeks. Include a timeline for each specific follow-up action you will be taking.
