RE: Violation of the Administrative Order issued on February 15, 2011 and possible civil penalties.

On February 15, 2011, the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Office of Environmental Public Health, Drinking Water Program (Program) issued an Administrative Order to you requiring corrective action to be completed at the Belle Passi Estates water system (PWS ID# OR4101221).

Specifically, the Administrative Order required that you submit sampling results to the Program, collected at the Belle Passi Estates water system, that demonstrate the drinking water has levels of arsenic below the maximum contaminant level (MCL). These sampling results were required to be submitted no later than December 31, 2011. December 31, 2011 has passed without submission of the samples or demonstration that the Belle Passi Estates water system is in compliance with the MCL for arsenic.

You are now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Belle Passi Estates water system is in violation of a rule (OAR 333-061-0090).

If the Program intends to assess a civil penalty against you, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).
