RE: Violation of the Notice of Non-Compliance dated April 8, 2013 and possible civil penalties.

The Oregon Health Authority, Drinking Water Services (DWS) issued a Notice of Non-Compliance to you on April 8, 2013 requiring corrective actions to be completed at the Desert Springs public water system (PWS ID# OR4101259).

Specifically, the Notice of Non-Compliance required a backflow annual summary report be submitted, a certified operator be designated, and significant deficiencies be corrected. Each of these requirements was due to be completed no later than May 31, 2013, but that date has passed without completion of the required actions.

You are now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Desert Springs water system is in violation of a rule (Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0090).

In the event that DWS assesses a civil penalty against you, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).
