Dear Mr. Matthais:

A water system survey was completed for West Linn/Wilsonville (admin) on 6-23-15 identifying significant deficiencies and rule violations to be corrected. A letter and copy of the survey report were mailed to your attention on 8-6-15. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-061-0076(6) and OAR 333-061-0032(6)(e) requires water systems that use groundwater sources to have completed corrective action or be in compliance with a Department-approved corrective action plan within 120 days of receiving written notice of a significant deficiency.

The West Linn/Wilsonville was to complete corrective action by 12-6-15 or have a Department-approved corrective action plan with a reasonable timeframe to complete the corrective action. To date, this information has not been received. As a result, the West Linn/Wilsonville is in violation and is now subject to formal enforcement which could include the assessment of civil penalties. In order to return to compliance and avoid formal enforcement action, your corrective action plan to the water system survey report **must be received and approved by 5-11-16**. Please send information to this office. A copy of the survey letter is enclosed for your reference.
