RE: Compliance Schedule for Violations at the Scappoose Adventist School public water system

Dear Larry Gibson,

This letter is a follow-up to our previous conversation regarding the timeframe for correction of the violations specified below at the Scappoose Adventist School. As we discussed, when a public water system has unresolved violations for more than 5 months, these violations must then be resolved before 9-30-15 or the water system will be referred for formal enforcement.

The Scappoose Adventist School water system has the following violations that must be resolved before 9-30-15.

Violation #1: OAR 333-061-0025(1)

Per our conversations, you have agreed to resolve the above violations according to the following compliance schedule:

- 1) The water system must monitor for Nitrate, Synthetic Organic Compounds, and Volatile Organic Compounds, and report the results to the state by 9-30-15.
- 2) The water system must monitor for 5 Lead & Copper tap samples at approved locations and report the results to the state by 9-30-15.
- 3) The water system must monitor for Coliform bacteria at the well (source) and report the results to the state by 9-30-15.

Failure to comply with the above compliance schedule may result in formal enforcement action which could include the assessment of civil penalties. If you have any questions or concerns, please call me at (503) 397-4651 X 2006.
